ANGEL BROWN COLLECTIONS: Name Sheets

The collection consists of three different collections. These collections are identified as Angel Brown Collection #1, #2, #3. The collection was placed into the lateral cabinets as it came out of the previous file cabinets where they were housed. The collection is in the lateral file cabinets lettered A-E. The cabinets have five drawers. The files within the drawers are Mrs. Angel Brown personal name sheet collection. The term name sheet in this collection means each file is made up of individual letter size sheets of paper that contain a name and location from which the information for the name was obtained. Some sheets contain just a name and origin location, while others have siblings, spouses, parents, and date of birth.

It is recommended that when a file is removed the information found within the sheets of that file should be rewritten in a menu style format. For example:

Adame, A	Monclova,
Adame, B	Coahuila
Beto, F	San Antonio.

This format would reduce the amount of paper in the files. As the collection stands now, each name takes one page of paper. 100 names=100 sheets.
